#### **Concord Primary Maths Challenge (CPMC)**

This mathematics challenge is open to children in Years 3 to 6 (ages 7 to 10) and provides a comprehensive evaluation of each child's mathematical abilities.

# 1. Who is eligible to participate in the CPMC?

Children currently studying in Years 3 to 6 (aged 7+ to 10+) in the 2024/2025 academic year

### 2. What is the participation fee?

The participation fee is RM50.00 per entry and must be paid at the time of registration. There will be no cancellations or refunds for any circumstances. The fees include Certificate of Participation, Mystery Door Gifts, Parent's Talk, Light Breakfast and Lunch etc.

### 3. How many categories of Challenge are there in CPMC?

The CPMC is divided into 2 categories. Both categories will take place during the same period.

CPMC Category 1: Years 3 and 4

CPMC Category 2: Years 5 and 6

# 4. How many seats are available in the CPMC?

The CPMC is limited to 100 participants per category, on a First Come, First Served basis.

### 5. What is the format of the CPMC?

- 40 minutes per challenge
- All answers must be written in English
- Years 3 and 4 Mathematics paper consists of 17 short-answer questions
- Years 5 and 6 Mathematics paper consists of 14 short-answer questions

# 6. What are the units of study for CPMC?

The units of study for CPMC include the following topics:

- Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Shape
- Length and Heigh
- Mass and Volume
- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions
- Position and Direction
- Money
- Time

### 8. When is the deadline for CPMC registration?

The deadline for registration is 21st January 2025 (Tuesday), before 5:00PM

### 9. When will the CPMC take place?

CPMC will be held on the 25<sup>th</sup> January 2025 (Saturday) from 09:00 to 14:00 at Concord College International School Malaysia

# 10. What should I bring on challenge day?

Participants must bring their original MyKid card or passport, as per the registered name.

# 11. Are we required to bring our own stationery?

No, stationery will be provided. No materials or digital products (e.g., reference books, pencils, mobile phones, electronic devices, calculators, digital watches etc) are permitted in the exam centre.

# 12. Can I obtain a copy of the CPMC papers after marking?

No, participants are not allowed to keep the papers. The papers will be collected and kept by Concord Admission Team.

### 13. How are the winners determined?

Winners will be determined based on their accuracy and completion rate. For example, the participant who provides the most accurate answers in the shortest time will be ranked as First Place and is then continued.

### 14. When will the CPMC winners be announced?

The winners of CPMC will be announced on the same day during the prize giving ceremony. Participants are required to stay for the prize giving ceremony. If a participant fails to attend, his/her entry will be deemed disqualified.
